
KG HAPPENINGS

A talk on the importance of YOGA was given by the teachers.A few yogasanas were demonstrated and students were asked to Meditate & do Pranayam.
























JULY 06/07/21
























SEPTEMBER 04/09/21

04/10/21 Gandhi Jayanthi was celebrated online with patriotic fervor. The students dressed as National Leaders and Gandhiji














































Republic Day was celebrated online by our Tiny Tots. The teachers explained the importance of the Day and sang some National Songs and told them some real incidents from History.









































21/02/22














26/02/22
